ARTICLE I  
**Patio Woodburning Units**  
**[Adopted 10-2-2007 by Ord. No. 7-07]**

**§ 34A-1. Definitions.**

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

**PATIO WOODBURNING UNIT** — A chimnea, patio warmer, wood-fired boiler, stove furnace, or other portable woodburning device used for outdoor recreation and/or heating.

**§ 34A-2. Conditions of use.**

A patio woodburning unit may be installed and used in the Borough of Pennsburg only in accordance with the following provisions:

- A. The patio woodburning unit shall not be used to burn refuse.
- B. The patio woodburning unit shall burn only clean wood or approved alternatives.
- C. The patio woodburning unit shall be located at least 25 feet from the nearest structure which is not on the same property as the patio woodburning unit and at least 15 feet from the nearest structure which is located on the same property as the patio woodburning unit.
- D. The patio woodburning unit shall not cause a nuisance to neighbors.
- E. The patio woodburning unit must be used properly following all manufacturer's specifications.
- F. The patio woodburning unit must be UL listed or approved by the Borough Fire Marshal, Borough Fire Chief and/or Borough Code Enforcement Officer.
