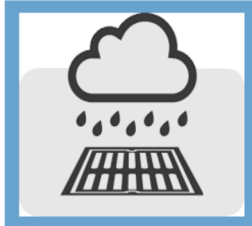

RAIN WATER POLLUTION. HOW CAN YOU HELP?



Rain is an important part of nature's water cycle, but there are times it can do more damage than good.

As excess rain water flows through our community, it picks up debris and pollutants which can clog drains and potentially contaminate our waterways.

How can you help? Creating a rain garden on your property is a great way to filter rain water. You can also limit lawn care chemicals, clean up pet waste and loose trash, and address vehicle leaks. Most importantly, report any hazardous events including construction debris to the Borough!

TRASH & RECYCLING PICK-UP

Trash & recycling is picked up weekly on Wednesday. All totes should be placed out for pick up with handles away from the roadway before 6:00 A.M. If possible, allow four feet between totes and keep away from cars, trees and mailboxes.

THE FOLLOWING 2022 HOLIDAYS WILL BE ALTERED:

Memorial Day—Pickup Thursday, June 2nd

Independence Day—Pickup Thursday, July 7th

Labor Day—Pickup Thursday, September 8th

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

All residents will use the provided recycling tote for comingled recycling. Place empty/rinsed items directly in the tote. Please do not bag recyclables.

ACCEPTED ITEMS:

Glass bottles and jars, aluminum and metal cans, plastic bottles and containers #1 through #7 (lids removed), cereal boxes, junk mail, brown paper bags, magazines, newsprint and cardboard. Cardboard must be flattened/broken down.

Do Not Include: food waste, plastic bags, polystyrene foam cups and containers, needles, tissues, paper towels, napkins & shredded paper.

TRASH REMOVAL

Residents are required to use the Waste Management provided 96 gallon green lid tote for trash collection. Any excess trash (outside of the tote) can be in 33-gallon user provided bags with a maximum of (2) additional bags.

SOLID WASTE ACCEPTED: All ordinary household trash and garbage and non-recycled materials. Tires, TV's, electronic devices and hazardous waste will NOT be accepted.

Totes are not owned by residents and must remain with the property.

If you have any issues with your trash and recycling collection, please call Waste Management directly at 1-800-869-5566.

If trash or recycling is not picked up on schedule, leave your tote out for pickup next morning.

BULK ITEMS

Pick up of large items such as appliances, furniture, AC units, dehumidifiers, etc. are not included in your weekly trash service. Call Waste Management at 1-800-869-5566 for fees or contact a hauler of your choice. There will be a bulk pickup event in 2022.

ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

TV's, computers, monitors, etc. cannot be disposed of in the trash or recycling totes. Visit our website for Montgomery County's Recycling information, along with other programs in our area. You can also call the Palm Business Center at (215) 679-4119 or go to: www.palmbusinesscenter.com.

BRANCH PICK-UP

Chipping takes place **every Monday** in April & October, and the 2nd Monday (weather permitting) of the following dates

May 9, June 13, July 11, August 8 & September 12

- If there is inclement weather, pickup will be the next nice day.
- Neatly place branches no larger than 2 inches in diameter at your trash pick-up location. Put small pieces in a container.
- There is a 10 minute time limit per property.
- Grass, weeds, flowers, vines, branches with fruit, lumber and downed trees (cut down or fallen trees) will not be accepted.
- **Christmas trees will be picked up every week in January.**

STREET SWEEPING

PERMITS, ZONING & INSPECTIONS

- Permits and inspections are required for sheds, decks, signs, fences, chimineas, driveways, roofs, additions, pools and other projects. Check our website for more information on permits & inspections required in the borough.
- A Use & Occupancy inspection is required each time there is a change in property ownership.
- Rental units and tenants must be reported to the borough. Rental inspections are required every three years or upon a change in tenant(s).
- **OPEN BURNING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE BOROUGH.**
